

Instructions for the Submission of the Scientific POSTER

Content Planning

It is essential to organize your information clearly. Use the official Scientific Poster Template provided. *A poster shows, it doesn't tell.*

Sections to include:

- **Title**
- **Authors:** List full names and surnames, identifying their order with a superscript number next to the surname, as shown in the template.
- **Introduction:** A brief text providing the research context or problem statement.
- **Objectives and/or Hypothesis:** State them explicitly and briefly.
- **Methodology:** Describe *how* the study was conducted, but in a simplified manner. Use lists or bullet points.
- **Results:** This is the most important section. Avoid long text. Use charts, tables, or infographics to present data in a visually impactful way.
- **Conclusions:** Summarize the main findings and their implications clearly and directly.
- **References:** Include only the most essential and relevant sources. It is **not necessary** to list all the references from your full paper.

General Considerations

- **Design:** Do not modify the layout, colors font established in the official template.
- **Typography:** Choose a font size that ensures easy readability. Remember, the poster should be mostly visual.

Including Content and Graphics

- **Text:** Copy and paste your prepared content into the template, adjusting the text to fit columns and font size appropriately.
- **Visuals:**
 - Create your charts (bar, pie, or line graphs) in Excel or Google Sheets.
 - Save your visuals as high resolution images (.png) to prevent quality loss when enlarged.

Additional Elements:

- You may include a **QR code** linking to your full article or your email address.

Final Review and Submission

- Proofread for spelling and grammar mistakes are highly visible on posters.
- **Check the design:** Ask a colleague to review it and confirm that the information is easily understood at a glance.

Export and Format:

- Save your scientific poster in high resolution.
- The final file must be uploaded in **PDF format** and must consist of **only one page**.
